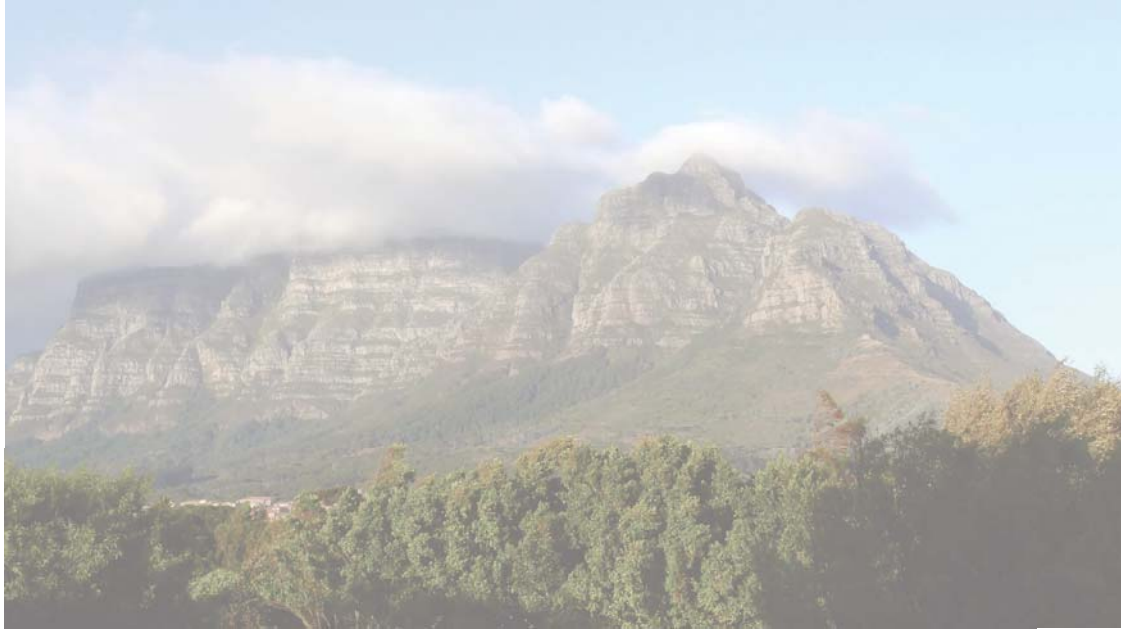


IBA African Regional Conference 2010
